#### Donations to the School:

- Teacher desks 4 desks are requested, we can get 4 desks \$75 each = \$300. **Motion approved** getting desks.
- Nov. 19<sup>th</sup> Grade 3-5<sup>th</sup> to Verizon Center for Monarchs Game they will be doing contests during the game. They will be back at 1:15, we need 4 buses @ \$271/each = \$1,084. **Motion Approved.**
- Folding Tables they are disappearing, used for communitee events. Need to buy 10 like at Sam's \$50/each = \$500. Motion Approved.
- Cheerleading mats Lori Collins has tried to get Cheer coach but no one wants to teach here b/c we are not safe and we don't have the right equipment.
  - St. Joseph's has mats and will sell us their Cheer mats b/c they don't have a team. They were purchased 4 years ago and used only 4-5 times for \$5,000 and we could buy them for \$2,500.

- o Lori Collins will go Friday Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> with someone that can help assess the quality and value of the mats.
- Mr. T also stated he could use them for many other things including gymnastics and team building to augment the physical education program.
- ACTION
  - Find out how long they last so PTA understands how long the investment will last
  - PTA approved \$2,500 for mats; Laura will go and see them with contacts that know more about them.
  - Analysis/comparison will be done whether we should purchase these used ones or buy new – PTA would be willing to purchase new if it makes more sense.
  - Need to compare cleanliness, quality, how long used ones will last vs. new ones etc.
  - Would need to clean the mats
- o **Approved to hold \$2,500 to purchase mats**. This will allow Lori Collins to go and see the mats at St. Joseph's Friday and "hold" them if the look good. Comparison will be done between what can be purchased new vs. what St. Joseph's is selling.
- Note The PTA has \$8K in a bank account
