UPDATE:

- Breakfast with Santa, that typically happens simultaneously in the caf, is sponsored by the Library and was cancelled (COVID?)

 - We did hire a Santa but still didn't draw enough of a turnout
- Not as many vendors were interested this year (COVID?) nice to spread them out, but less revenue for vendor fees
- Turnout was very low weather and Covid played a part
 - Dec 11th date too close to Christmas? people avoiding crowds to stay healthy for holidays? Consider moving fair date to November for 2022?

- Saturdays are typically busier for people (errands, sports, etc.) consider fair date on a Sunday for 2022?
- PTA member wondered if there was enough advertising for Fair Date since Santa breakfast was cancelled – Announced on Facebook in multiple groups and on Bloomz and a handout went home with kids (not sure how else to reach Auburn families?)

 - Covid related but also kids not quite ready
 - No rescheduled date yet
- Monday 1/24 starts Trimester 2B schedules will change for some students
- Thursday 1/27 Pinkerton Course night will be held online
- Thursday 1/27 in person Field Trip for 8th graders to Pinkerton to learn about elective programs available up in the air right now if this will happen due to state of Covid
- Athletics Update Both girls and boys Basketball in 2nd place
 - AVS will host 1st round playoffs dates not finalized yet
- Pinkerton course selections once sent out to parents will need to hear back by 2/4
- 8th grade graduation dates still not finalized still in flux due to Covid

School Board Update- Adrian Newton UPDATE:

- COVID: the next 6-8 weeks are expected to be difficult as more staff are quarantined
 - It is a daily conversation between Dr. Collins and Superintendent if there are sufficient teachers and staffing to safely open the school each day

- January 11th "snow day" was used due to staffing issues
 - May happen again this winter if staffing is too low to allow students to safely be in building
- Budget if approved will include a new part time Spanish teacher
- Pinkerton Liason, Mary LaChance, (junior) comes to all school board meetings great to get her updates
- Strategic Planning committee has been formed first meeting 1/20 to help plan for the next 3-5 year outlook for AVS
- Baseball and Softball fields have been confirmed to be opened in spring
 - Current proposal for a new score board
- Board approved draft calendar for 2022-2023 school year
 - First Day 8/31/22
 - Last Day 6/15/22
